MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card/Valid yellow form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC ILP or PAL number. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on a dirt surface. Each ring size will measure 90' x 100'.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place.....*Blue*
Second Place.....*Red*
Third Place.....*Yellow*
Fourth Place.....*White*
Qualifying Score.....*Dark Green*

A New Title medallion will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH/PAX rosette and decorated MACH/PAX bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH/PAX.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Charlottesville Albemarle Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. **CAKC** reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the CAKC or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. **As such, the club will refund all but \$15 per day of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate.** This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging, if a valid copy of their jump height card was sent with their entry. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

CATALOGS

Advance catalogs may be ordered and prepaid on your entry form for \$15. A limited number of catalogs will be available for sale at the trial site for a cost of \$18. Running order sheets will be available to all exhibitors at no charge.

Directions to Trial Site

From East and West – Take Interstate 64. Take exit 120, Fifth Street. Turn south at the end of the ramp onto Route 631, which is also known as Fifth Street. This road starts out big (two lanes each way) but narrows quickly to a single lane country road. After approximately two miles you’ll pass an odd mailbox for the Biscuit Run ceramic studio. Slow down and look for Forest Lodge Lane, on the left, towards the bottom of the hill. Turn into the drive way and take the left fork. Go through the gate and park around the arena.

From South – From Route 29 North, take the exit for Interstate 64 East and take exit 120 and follow the directions in italics above.

From North – Take US 29 South towards Lynchburg. Go approximately 4 miles and take Interstate 64 East and exit 120 and follow the directions in italics above.

All terms defined by the Act shall have the same meaning herein, and the Act is hereby incorporated in this agreement by reference. This agreement shall be so construed as to provide to (the sponsor professional) the fullest protection of a release, waiver of right to sue and assumption of all risks which is afforded to it by the Act.

The participant hereby acknowledges that he / she has full and complete notice and understanding of all risks inherent in equine activities which may cause, contribute to or result in death or personal injury of the participant or damage to the participant's property (the risks, including but not necessarily limited to: the

propensity of any equine to behave in dangerous ways or to trip or to fall; the inability to predict an equine's reaction to sound, movements, objects, persons, animals, excitement, weather conditions, and all types of creatures. The effect of such reactions, the hazards of surface or subsurface conditions including objects or condition under, or protruding from the surface, whether apparent or not.

The participant hereby acknowledges that riding an equine is a high risk sport and that he / she is participating at his / her own risk.

Participant hereby Releases and Waives all rights which he / she may have or hereafter have against **(the barn manager *, property owner(s) , and all their employees, officials or agents* "and each owner for death, personal injury, or property damage which is in any way associated with the risks and he / she does hereby waive his/ her right to sue or to bring any action against any of the foregoing in connection therewith. He / She further agrees to indemnify and defend the sponsor / professional and each owner from and to hold each of them harmless against any such suit or action.

If this agreement is executed by the undersigned participant for and on behalf of a minor participant, the undersigned participant hereby warrants and represents that he / she is in fact the legal parent or guardian of such minor with full rights of custody and control; that this agreement is given on behalf of and is intended to be binding upon said minor participant and the heirs, personal representatives, successors and assigns of any participant: and the undersigned participant further agrees that this agreement shall also be as fully binding on the undersigned participant as if it were entered into solely on his / her behalf.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
