

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

NOTE: Armbands will not be mailed. They will be available at self check-in on trial days. If you have not provided jump height card photocopies for ALL dogs entered before the trials, these must be provided at trial check-in before armbands will be issued.

First Received/Hand Deliveries – Entries received within 24 hrs. of the opening date and time must be mailed/delivered to the Trial Secretary's P.O. Box via any commercial delivery method. No hand carries will be accepted during this period. If these conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and are able to perform all obstacles safely.

There is plenty of indoor crating space. Please crate in the areas (fields) as directed.

ALL crate/ex-pen setups and chairs MUST have a tarp or other form of protection underneath in order to protect the field turf surface from damage.

Chairs only (no crating) in the two fields containing the Std. and JWW rings. Chairs must have a barrier placed underneath them to protect the field turf surface.

Puppies under 6 months of age are strictly prohibited from the grounds. All dogs must be on a leash at all times on the grounds except when in the ring, when in the designated agility warm-up area, when crated, or when in a secure ex-pen. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Catalogs will be available for sale (very limited quantity) at the trial for \$15.00 each.

It is expressly understood that **exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children.** Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund will be made of any entry fees paid.

Refunds (all but \$15 per dog per day of the entry fees) will be made for **bitches in season only.** (Veterinarian's note or other form of proof must be presented.) The Trial Secretary must be notified of such claims for refund in writing no later than noon on the trial date (preferably as early as possible after the closing of entries).

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

THE NUMBER OF ENTRIES WILL BE LIMITED TO 660 RUNS PER DAY

ENTRY FEES: \$22 for first entry & \$13 for second entry of same dog on same day. (Fees include \$3.00 AKC recording fee per run.)

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRIES: Preliminary confirmations will be sent to all exhibitors who provide a **legible, non-blocked e-mail address**, SASE or postcard. Final confirmations/judging programs will also be sent via e-mail to those providing e-mail addresses. These will be sent after the closing date of May 8, 2009. *Telephone messages concerning the trials will be returned on a collect basis.*

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dogs in each jump height division in each class. Qualifying ribbons and toys/treats (valued at \$1 - \$3) will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. Dogs must qualify to receive placement or qualifying ribbons and prizes. Perfect score ribbons for Novice, Open and Excellent A classes will also be awarded.

New title rosettes and special MX/MXJ dog neck rosettes will be awarded. Those completing MX or MXJ titles will also receive treat jars in memory of U-ACHX U-CDX EZ Back To Skool Saddle Shoe VCD2 MX MXJ ("Lacey").

Those completing MACHs will receive a special rosette, MACH bar, and an engraved cherrywood box in memory of U-ACHX Ch. Ging's Diamond Dust VCD2 MX MXJ ("Slider").

Those completing PAXs (Preferred Agility Excellent title) will receive a special rosette and jump bar in memory of MACH Tallymark's Country Classic CD ("Ricky").

HS Cocker in each class - Dog neck rosettes will be offered. Also, a special logo/breed item will be offered to each owner (or one co-owner) per weekend entering a Cocker Spaniel.

CLASS INFORMATION

Regular and Preferred Classes will be offered each day. Dogs shall not be eligible to participate in more than one Regular Standard Class & one Regular Jumpers with Weaves (JWW) class OR one Preferred Standard Class and one Preferred JWW Class in any AKC agility trial. Dogs must be entered ONLY in Regular Classes or ONLY in Preferred Classes, with no crossover between them being allowed at the same set of trials.

Novice Agility Class (Std. or JWW)

The Novice Agility class is divided into Division A for persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title from any organization, and Division B for dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility title, persons that have handled a dog to an agility title, and agility judges.

Open Agility Class (Std. or JWW)

Open to dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility or Open Agility titles, but that have not acquired a qualifying score toward the Agility Excellent title.

Agility Excellent Class (Std. or JWW)

Division A is for dogs that have acquired the Open Agility title but that have not acquired a qualifying score in the Excellent B Class. Division B is for dogs that have acquired the AX (or AXJ) title and for dogs that have acquired the MX (or MXJ) title.

PREFERRED CLASS INFORMATION

The owner/handler may choose to enter the Preferred Standard Class and Preferred JWW Class in lieu of entering the Regular Standard Class and the Regular JWW Class. The dog must be entered only in Preferred Classes or only in Regular Classes, with no crossover between them being allowed at the same set of trials. All dogs entering the Preferred Classes for the first time MUST enter the Novice level in the Preferred Standard Agility Class and/or the Preferred JWW class regardless of their previous title level in the Regular Classes or from the Preferred Classes to the Regular Classes.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division.

All dogs that have not provided a photocopy of a permanent or valid temporary Jump Height Card with their entry and/or those not presenting an original permanent or valid temporary Jump Height Card on the day of the trial shall be measured by a judge of record prior to competing (except those in the 24" or 26" height divisions).

If a dog's height at the withers exceeds the maximum allowed for the jump height in which the dog is entered, the dog shall be moved up into the proper jump height if the dog is measured prior to its run. In no case may a dog be moved down in height based on a judge's measurement at a trial (except for preferred classes). **Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated.**

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have an AKC limited registration, or are of a registerable breed that have obtained an ILP number from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the AKC Registration and Discipline Rules for a list of registerable breeds that may participate.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION (WALK-THROUGHS) AND WARM-UPS: Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk-through allows handlers to plan their strategy for running the course. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class, before or after the judge's briefing. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided.

CLASS ORDER

This is a two-ring, two-judge trial. Regular Classes will be followed by Preferred Classes within each class, division and jump height. In all Excellent and Novice classes, A and B classes will run concurrently. Standard and JWW classes will be judged in the following order each day:

Standard Ring:

(Note: this ring starts at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday and 8:00 a.m. on Sunday) - Excellent, Open, Novice

JWW Ring: (starts 30 minutes after start of Standard Classes) - Open, Novice, Excellent

No FAST classes will be offered at these trials.

Running Order will be determined at the time of closing of entries and will be included in the Judging Schedule, which will be sent to all exhibitors.

Move-Ups for Saturday, May 23 must be received in writing (e-mail is preferable) by the Trial Secretary no later than 6:00 p.m. on Monday, May 18, 2009. Move-ups for Sunday, May 24 must be made by the end of the trial on May 23. Dogs moved up will be entered at the end of the running order.

2. Crating areas will be in other field turf ring(s) not used for competition. **All crates, ex-pens, chairs etc. set up anywhere on field turf MUST have protective barrier underneath.**
3. Dogs must be "exercised" in the designated areas outside. ALL dog debris MUST be picked up and placed in proper outdoor containers.
4. **All exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs and themselves - indoors or outdoors.** Be very vigilant about dogs at doorways, corners, etc., in order to avoid indoor accidents.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes and the FAST titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.
