Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Please mail a copy of the AKC Jump Height Card with your entry. All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card/Valid yellow form and exhibitors must be able to present it prior to running their dog(s) in any class or at any time during the trial upon request whether or not they have sent a copy of such with their entry. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" and 26" height divisions. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

RANDOM DRAW

Random Draw rules & regulations appear in Chapter 1, Section 11 of the *Regulations for Agility Trials*. Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum and/or entries received prior to the opening date shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender. In the event an envelope is drawn that contains entries that would exceed the entry limit, there will be a random draw of the individual entries contained therein to fill the specified entry limit. Express delivery entries must include a signed signature waiver. If entry limits are not reached during the opening period, they will be filled on a "first received" basis until the closing date. If limits are reached before closing, a wait list of no more than 25 dogs will be kept. Final confirmations will be e-mailed if an email address is given on the entry form.

If you wish to know if you made the draw before final confirmation letters go out, please include a legible, working, **non-blocked** e-mail address or a self-addressed, stamped postcard or envelope. **Entries not making the draw or entries that are withdrawn will not be returned. These entry checks will be shredded.**

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, have AKC Limited Registration, have obtained an AKC ILP or PAL number or are an Approved FSS Breed. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. Umbrellas are not allowed on the course during the walk-throughs.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RINGS AND SITE INFORMATION

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

All classes will take place outdoors on a grass surface. Each ring will be 100' x 100'.

Bring your own chairs & shade. There is some shade available including a pole building adjacent to the rings for crating (**no ex-pens please**). Tents are allowed but must be set up beyond an area around the rings as designated by the trial committee. Water is available at the trial site.

A food concession will be available on the site.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:
First Place.....*Blue*
Second Place.....*Red*
Third Place.....*Yellow*
Fourth Place.....*White*

A green ribbon will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs in Novice & Open Classes that have a clean run will receive a ribbon. A rosette will be awarded to dogs completing a title. A rosette and decorated bar will be awarded to dog and handler teams that attain their MACH/PAX. A dog toy or bag of treats (valued at under \$3.00) will be awarded to all dogs that qualify. All prizes and awards must be claimed at the trials; none will be mailed.

MOVE-UPS

Move-up requests must be made to the Trial Secretary by 6:00 pm on Monday, Sept. 7, 2009 by mail or email. Day to Day move-ups are allowed. Requests to move-up from the Fri. to Sat. trial must be made to the Secretary within ½ hour after the last class on Friday. Requests to move up from the Sat. to Sun. trial must be made to the Secretary within ½ hour after the last class on Saturday.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

Please note: If using a GPS, use Upperville in place of Rectortown.

Take I-66 to Exit #28 (Route 17). Follow Business 17 to Marshall. At the intersection of Business 17 & Rt. 55 go through light & proceed straight ahead (North) on Rt. 710 (Rectortown Rd.). Follow Rt. 710 to Rectortown. Turn right on Rt. 624 (Crenshaw Rd.) & go approximately ½ mile to the Warrenton KC Show Grounds on the right.

Entries will be chosen by "Random Draw." Telephone, Telegraph, E-mail, Telefax & Unsigned Entries Cannot Be Accepted. No entry shall be made & no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Incomplete, illegible entries or entries received without fees will not be accepted. Post-dated or returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. All returned checks will have a collection fee of \$25 added.

Entries must be on official AKC entry forms or copies & must include the Agreement & Rules from the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form. Junior handlers must complete the back of the form. Include only AKC titles on entry.

CORRECTIONS, CHANGES & REFUNDS: Entry form changes, additions, corrections & cancellations MUST be received in writing or e-mail prior to the closing time and date (6:00 pm, Aug. 21, 09). Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, & no entry fees will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the closing date.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee or judge. No refunds will be given if it is deemed necessary to cancel or stop a trial for the safety of dogs & people because of, but not limited to, riots, civil disturbances, extreme weather conditions (such as hurricanes, lightning or extreme heat), or other causes beyond the control of the organizing clubs. **Bitches in Season** will not be admitted to the Trial. Entry fees will be refunded, less \$15.00 a day, upon written certification by a Veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the Trial Secretary no later than 8:00 am on the day of the trial.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY: The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Potomac Valley Belgian Sheepdog Club and the Warrenton Kennel Club and their agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. **The Potomac Valley Belgian Sheepdog Club and the Warrenton Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression.** No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Potomac Valley Belgian Sheepdog Club and the Warrenton Kennel Club or any official thereof.

RINGSIDE: Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging, if a valid copy of their jump height card was sent with their entry. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

All dogs present must be on leash or confined to a crate at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course. No dogs allowed within the boundaries of the designated trial limits except for those entered in the trial.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

Catalogs will be available for sale at the trial site at \$15.00 for a set for all three days, but supplies will be limited.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all *Regular* titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
